ProcedurePlace the infant supine (lying on their back) on a flat, stable surface. Identify the Anterior Superior Iliac Spine (ASIS) and the greater trochanter of the femur. Place one finger on the ASIS and another finger on the greater trochanter, forming a line between these points. Observe the position of the umbilicus relative to this line.

Scoring and interpretationNegative: If the line passes above or through the umbilicus, the test is usually considered negative (no dislocation). Positive: If the line passes below the umbilicus, the test may be considered positive (potential hip dysplasia).
